

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

ABOUT THE HOME FOR COOPERATION LANGUAGE CLASSES

1. When do the Language Classes start and finish?

The Language Classes both in Greek and Turkish begin in the week of the 7th of October 2024 and conclude in the week 13th of June 2025.

If the class you have selected is on Thursdays, then your first class would be on the 10th of October.

2. What is the difference between Language Classes and Conversation Sessions?

Language classes focus on learning the alphabet, vocabulary, learn how to hold simple or complicated conversations, depending on the teaching level, learn how to read and write, among other things. For each language level, classes take place once a week for 1.5 hours.

Conversation sessions focus on speaking. They are an opportunity for language students or anyone else who may not attend the language classes, to find themselves as parts of the group with the aim of practicing the language, focusing on pronunciation and local expressions. The conversation sessions take place once a week for 1.5 hours.

3. I want to attend the Language Classes but not the Conversation Sessions. Is this possible?

Yes. On the H4C website, you can select the language class you want to attend and proceed with your registration.

4. I want to attend the Conversation Sessions but not the Language Classes. Is this possible?

Yes. On the H4C website, you can select the conversation session you want to attend and proceed with your registration.

5. Where do the language classes take place?

The classes take place ONLINE via ZOOM.

6. Where do the conversation sessions take place?

The classes take place ONLINE via ZOOM.

7. How much does it cost?

Registration for LANGUAGE CLASS is €300, for the whole academic period.

Registration for CONVERSATION SESSIONS is €150, for the whole academic period.

8. How many students are in a class?

The minimum number is 5 and the maximum number is 10.

10. How can I know which class to sign up for?

[On the H4C website](#), there is a list of available classes. When you click on each of these, there is a short description of what to expect when you sign up to the specific language level.

On the first day of the classes, the language instructors conduct a mini quiz to ensure students' language level fits the selected class and will inform you if it is preferred to switch to another class.

11. How do I register?

To register for a language class/conversation session, you need to visit [our website](#) and select the language class of your preference. You can proceed with 'adding to cart' the selected class and make an online payment. Once the payment is made, the registration is complete.

12. How do I know my registration is complete?

Once the online payment is settled, you will receive a confirmation email via the website. This email may land in your spam folder. Then, a confirmation email will also be sent by the H4C team to share all information which you may need to know about your class.

13. What if I cannot make the payment online?

14. What if I cannot pay the whole amount in one instalment?
